East Kilbride Pipe Band

Band Constitution

1. The band shall be registered with the RSPBA as "East Kilbride Pipe Band".
2. The aims of the band shall be the furtherance of piping and drumming in both competitive and social fields.
3. The band shall be non-political and non-sectarian in both outlook and personnel.
4. The committee shall consist of 9 members: Chairman, Pipe Major, Drum Sergeant, Secretary, Treasurer, Quartermaster, Head Tutor, Fundraiser and Playing Member.
5. The committee shall meet once every quarter – 5 members needed to form a quorum.
6. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings and the Secretary shall keep a record of all business and minute the same.
7. The Treasurer shall keep a record of all financial transactions and bank all money – 2 signatories being necessary for all withdrawals and cheques.
8. The Annual General Meeting (AGM) shall be held in September each year.
9. Members are expected to attend all practices – members not attending for 3 consecutive weeks without reason, shall be contacted by either the Pipe Major or Drum Sergeant.
10. All band equipment shall be signed for on receipt by the member, and shall be returned immediately to the Quartermaster should the membership be terminated – any loss or damage to equipment shall be recompensed to the band.
11. The Pipe Sergeant and composition of the band shall be determined by the Pipe Major.
12. Discipline within the band must be maintained at all times and the Pipe Major or Drum Sergeant must be informed as early as possible should any member be unavailable for any engagements/competitions or attend band practice.
13. A monthly subscription fee shall be paid by all band members, and the amount for the forthcoming year agreed upon annually at the AGM.
